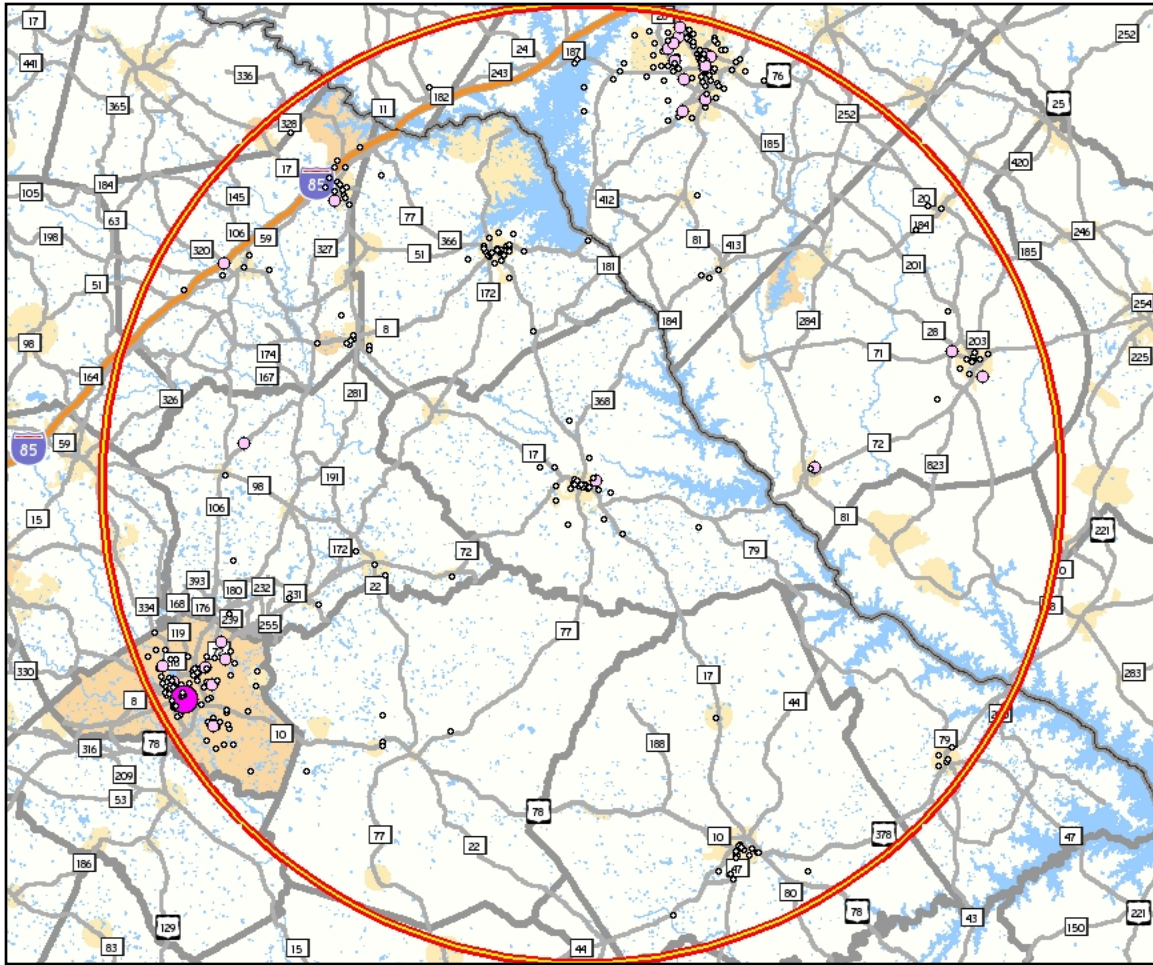
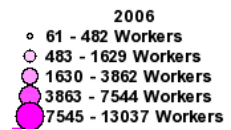


# Elbert Co Regional Workforce 32 miles
